Providence University Regulations on the Pilot International Program

Adopted at the Academic Affairs Meeting on June 4, 2008

- Article 1 The Providence University Regulations on the Pilot International Program (hereinafter referred to as the “**Regulations**”) are established to further expand the degree of internationalization of the University and integrate the resources and features of the colleges.
- Article 2 The International Program (hereinafter referred to as the “**Program**”) is offered by colleges. The pertinent colleges shall submit to the Office of Academic Affairs an international program proposal, specifying the education goal, the attending departments, faculty, curriculum plan and credit hours, and application eligibility, etc. The proposal shall be submitted to the Academic Affairs Meeting for record prior to implementation.
- Article 3 The courses offered are mainly based on the existing required courses of the attending departments. Separate classes with English as the medium of instruction shall be offered. The minimum number of international students (including Overseas Chinese students) per class is three. The total number of credit hours of the Program is capped at 50 credits.
- Article 4 The pertinent departments participating in the Program shall recognize the curriculum and credit hours of the Program.
- Article 5 The teaching hours of the Program shall be listed as the additional hours to the maximum teaching load of the instructors.
- Article 6 These Regulations shall enter into force upon the approval of the Academic Affairs Meeting; the same procedure applies to the amendments. Matters not provided in these Regulations shall be subject to the pertinent regulations of the University and shall be reassessed after two years of trial.
