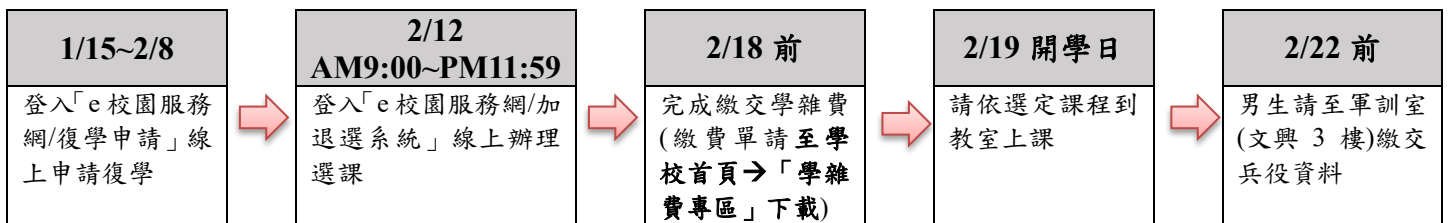

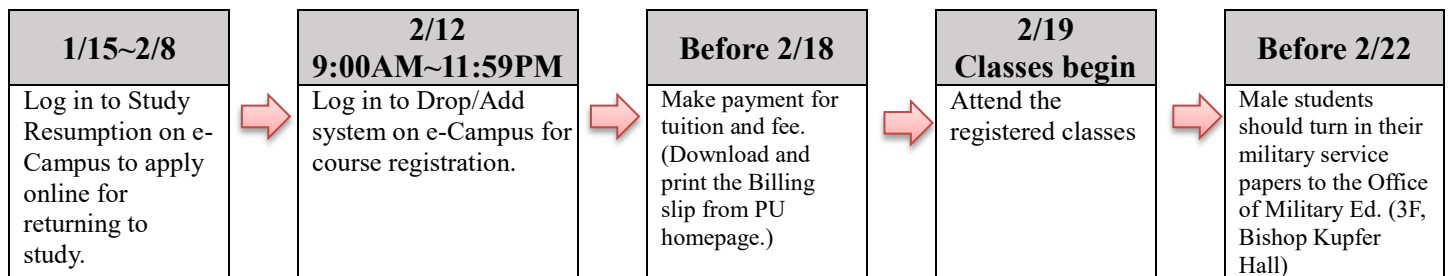
Subject: Notice for Resumption of Studies 2023-24AY 2nd Semester

Description:

1. All students on suspension of studies returning by regulations for the 2023-24AY 2nd Semester shall proceed to e-Campus between **January 15 and February 8, 2024** to file your application for study resumption and complete the relevant procedure (including course registration and payment.)

4. **For the students who wish to apply for early resumption of study in the 2023-24AY 2nd semester**, please follow the schedule of this notice. The payment should be made after the date of “**Online Course Registration for Resumption Students**”. Please Contact the Cashier’s Office (04-26328001, ext. 11310, 11313, 11314) to recalculate the tuition and miscellaneous fees.; then download and print the payment slip and **make the payment before the classes begin (February 18)**. Retain the transaction slips for future reference. (Check the tuition/fees payment at PU homepage for details of payment channel and instructions.)

5. Starting from the 112(2) semester, all bachelor's degree students in grades 1 to 4 with holding Taiwanese nationality (excluding those who have extended their study period) who are enrolled as active students (non-suspension status) from the opening day of the semester (113/2/19) and have not applied for other educational benefits and exemptions as outlined in (Note 1). They are eligible to enjoy a tuition and miscellaneous fee exemption of NT\$17,500 from the Executive Yuan (for details, please refer to the qualifications announced by the Student Affairs Office of our school). Students are required to complete all procedures for resumption of Studies, course selection, and registration payment by the last working day before the start of the semester (113/2/16) in order to be eligible to be as active student on the first day of school.
